



Project Workers Course

COURSE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

This course has been designed for those who are involved in providing services in an addiction service setting.

WHO SHOULD APPLY

This course is designed for anyone who works with individuals experiencing substance misuse problems in a community, clinical or counselling setting.

COURSE CONTENT:

- To introduce participants to the concepts of community development
- To identify different roles and responsibilities in projects
- To explore client's motivation for presenting at various projects (prelude to needs identification)
- To introduce participants to the concept of project working
- To identify different roles and responsibilities of project workers
- To explore the development of a care plan approach (needs identification, goal setting, advocacy/brokerage and tracking)
- To examine the rehabilitation process
- To introduce participants to basic attending and counselling skills
- To introduce participants to RT/CT
- To explore concept of connection and therapeutic relationships
- To introduce participants to cognitive behavioural coping skills and functional behavioural analysis. (as applicable to addiction/mental health settings/behavioural settings/childcare settings etc)
- To explore ethics and boundaries relating to project work
- To examine appropriate case note maintenance
- To discuss classifications of illicit substances commonly used in Ireland

COURSE STRUCTURE:

The core ethos of IICP is to provide a student centred, warm and supportive learning environment. The programme is highly interactive, experiential and taught through lectures, small group work, role-play and assignments.
